



NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS

300 North Street Roadway & Infrastructure Improvements Project
Department of Public Works & Civil Engineering

Date of Issue: May 26, 2026

Project Limits: 300 North Street, commencing from 200 West to approximately 364 West
Anticipated Schedule: June 1, 2026 – November 15, 2026 (Subject to weather conditions)

Work Hours: Monday – Friday, 7:00 AM – 6:00 PM (Occasional evening and weekend work if required)

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES: Comprehensive roadway reconstruction work will begin shortly within your area. This project will involve construction operations that will impact local traffic, street parking, and driveway access.

PROJECT OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

The objective of this project is to perform vital infrastructure upgrades, enhance stormwater management capabilities, and completely rehabilitate the roadway surface to optimize structural performance and modern safety standards.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS & ACCESS RULES

Lane Closures & Detours: 300 North Street within the project limits will experience intermittent lane closures, tapering down to single-lane configurations with flagger control. Complete short-term closures will occur during culvert placement and final paving operations. Detour routes will be clearly marked.

Driveway & Property Access: Property owners within the active zone may experience temporary loss of driveway access during pulverizing, excavation, and hot mix asphalt placement. The contracting crew will notify affected residents 24 to 48 hours prior to blocking specific driveways.

Street Parking: On-street parking will be strictly prohibited within the active construction zone. Vehicles parked within the marked zones during working hours will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

Pedestrian Safety: Pedestrians are advised to follow posted safety signage and remain clear of heavy machinery.

Public Safety Advisory

Construction zones present dynamic and inherently hazardous conditions. Heavy equipment, open excavations, and hot asphalt materials will be present. For your safety, we request that all residents, pedestrians, and motorists adhere strictly to all construction signage, barricades, and traffic control personnel directives. Please ensure children and pets are kept a safe distance away from all active construction zones.
